Entries: Will close at 8.00pm, Monday 20TH FEBRUARY 2012. Entries must be in the hands of the following ABS members by that time. No late entries will be accepted. Contact:

Entry fee of 60 cents per exhibit will apply, all entries to be paid for.

Staging: All exhibits must be staged between 7.45 and 8.45am on the day of the show.

Rings: Young birds must bear the registered number or code of the exhibitor on a closed 2011 ANBC approved ring. N/F & Juveniles will be 2012 rung birds. Old Birds to be rung with 2010 ring or earlier. Only one closed metal ring from any recognised society is permissible. Spot ring checks may be made.

Labels: To be affixed to bottom right hand corner of cage. Class labels and exhibitors portion will be posted at a cost of 80 cents unless otherwise stated.

Rules: The show will be conducted under the rules of the Australian Budgerigar Society Inc as interpreted by the Show Committee (ie SQBBA rules). All exhibitors acknowledge acceptance of these rules as a condition of entry. Purchased birds: Cannot be shown.

Cages: Only show cages which meet the A.N.B.C. show cage specification will be accepted. Any birds in dirty, marked or damaged cages will not be considered for awards. The Show Manager will inspect all cages prior to judging.

Seed: All Show Cages will contain a seed mixture suitable for budgerigars. No distinguishing seed such as sunflower seed to be used.

Judging: Judging will commence at 9.15am sharp. The judges decision will be final in all matters of merit.

Exhibits: All birds will be considered the property of the Society during the period of the show and they must not be touched or taken away without the permission of the Show Manager. All birds entered are at the sole risk of the exhibitor and the Society will not be held responsible for loss or injury.

Morning tea: Morning Tea will be provided free

Lunch: A great lunch will be available for a small cost. Exhibitors entering birds could you please advise with entries, the numbers requiring lunch.

Awards: Presentation of Awards will take place approx. 12.45pm.

Removal: Removal of birds shall be directly following presentation. All birds shall be gathered off the staging by the exhibitors and when the show manager is satisfied that everyone has their birds it will be announced that we can all go home at the same time.

Selling: Exhibitors are encouraged to bring along sale birds which will not be judged. Birds entered in this section at 50cents per bird with 10% of selling price going to the Society. Maximum of four birds per cage of varying colour and sex. Selling to general public to commence from 8.15am on a "first in first served basis" Millet sprays & water to be provided.

ABS DERBY BIRDS- Please advise if nominating an ABS Derby rung bird-any of your first 30 rung bird with rings purchased from the ABS club can be entered-Certificates for section winners & Trophy for Best Bird

Note: Any one wishing to assist on the day with staging, stewarding or in the kitchen please advise ABS, you are more than welcome to help. Remember stewarding is a great way to learn more about the birds. Can ABS members please bring an item for morning tea.

* When placing entries please ensure you state whether Any Age, Old, Young, Nestfeather or Juvenile birds are being entered.

* Green Series includes Light, Dark, Olive and Grey Green.

* Blue Series includes Skyblue, Cobalt, Mauve, Violet and Grey.

* All classes are in accordance with the ANBC Standard.

* Multiple factor birds exist in many combinations. Therefore, if the schedule does not list a certain colour/variety combination then these birds will go into the AOV and Non Standardised classes. Refer ANBC Standard colour matrix for combinations.

* Any bird carrying multiple factors will only be eligible for awards which can be directly taken by the particular class in which they are entered.

* If you have a bird carrying multiple variety factors, please refer to the colour matrix from the ANBC Standard to see what class you can enter your bird in. For example, if you have a bird that is visually a Dominant Pied, Yellowface, Opaline, Cinnamon and Grey you would check to see the highest section number in the matrix and if all the other factors are included, then that is the class to enter the bird in. In the instance of the bird described, Dominant Pied (sect 16) is the highest, Yellowface (sect 14) is included, so is Opaline (sect 10), cinnamon (sect 8) and grey (sect 4) is included in yellowface, so therefore is included in this instance. You would enter this particular bird as a Dominant Pied either class 29 or 30 dependant whether a cock or hen.

* Variable class to be nominated on the Show Schedule by each club as required.

Refer to SQBBA Schedule regarding variety combinations as set out by ANBC Standard.
